Ragging

Ragging is 'any act which causes or likely to cause physical or psychological injury or mental pain or fear to a student or a member of the staff of an educational institution' (UGC Act, No 20 of 1988).

Ragging

As per the University Grants Commission circular No. 919, an Anti Ragging Committee should be established in the University. Accordingly, the Faculty of Agriculture, RUSL has formulated an ARC in November 2017 following the guidelines of the same circular.

Anti Ragging Committee

- Dean
- Deputy proctor
- Wardens of male and female hostels
- Senior student counselor
- Sub-wardens of male and female hostels
- Two academic sub-wardens from each male and female hostels
- SAR- convener

"Any person who commits or participates in ragging within or outside the University shall be guilty of an offence"

Forms of Ragging

- Sexual harassments
- Verbal or written threats
- Any act affecting on personal liberty and freedom
- Unlawfully obstruction to anyone
- Unlawfully restraining anyone
- Physical injuries
- Other illegal actions
