Guidelines to Students after reopening the Faculty of Agriculture for the academic activities (2018/2019 intake) after COVID-19 outbreak

- All students should use the main entrance of the faculty for entering into the premises.
- Valid PHI Certificate must be submitted while entering into the premises and temperature will be checked while entering and time to time and any person recording a temperature above 98.4 °F or 37°C should not be allowed.
- Parents or visitors were not allowed to enter into the premises.
- Wash your hands with soap / handwash and water before entering the premises or alternatively use the hand sanitizer.
- Wash your hands with soap / handwash and water before entering and leaving hostels, lecture halls, laboratories, Library and other places or alternatively use the hand sanitizer.
- Keep Social distancing and always wear face mask inside the premises except your own hostel rooms.
- Students are not allowed to visit other students' hostel rooms.
- Encourage respiratory etiquette, including covering coughs and sneezes. Coughs and sneezes have to be covered by the inner side of elbow or sleeve. In a situation where this is not possible a tissue can be used to cover the nose/ mouth, provided the tissue is discarded into a closed bin and hands washed thereafter.
- Unwanted group gatherings were prohibited.
- All should wash hands with soap and water before meals and should use your own water bottles, tea cups and meal boxes / plates, own cutlery and you are requested to bring your own.
- Take away is only allowed in canteen or student centre and you should eat your all meals from your hostel rooms to reduce overcrowding.
- Use your own stationaries and belongings and avoid sharing.
- If anyone have fever, with or without acute onset respiratory symptoms such as cough, runny nose, sore throat and/or shortness of breath should inform to the sub-wardens of the respective hostels.
- Student should note the vehicle details including vehicle number for each travel while using public / private transport to arrive the faculty and each and every situation where they leave from the faculty premises.
- All students should report to hostels before 8.00 p.m every day.
- Adhere other good health practices to minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19.

If any student who is not adhered the above guidelines, the particular student will be sent out from the faculty immediately and not allowed to sit the forthcoming examinations.
